Section 1. Purpose and Intent

The purpose and intent of this Local Law is to promote the safety, health and welfare of school aged children traveling to and from certain school buildings located within the Village of Goshen. Review of the existing law in this regard reveals certain inconsistencies as well as the omission of certain qualifying highways that should be included in a School Speed Zone to ensure maximum safety of students who drive, walk and/or bicycle to and from the school facility.

Section 2. Code Amendments

Section 54-165 of the current Village Code entitled "Twenty Miles per Hour," is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Section 154-65. School Speed Zones – Twenty Miles per Hour.

In accordance with the applicable provisions of the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law, maximum school speed limits of 20 miles per hour are hereby established on the following designated highways and in the following designated areas on those highways:

- (a) Erie Street from its intersection with Main Street (NYS Route 207) to its terminus at Lincoln Avenue.
- (b) Murray Avenue between North Church Street and its intersection with Erie Street.
- (c) Scotchtown Avenue from the northerly Village line to its intersection with Murray Avenue.
- (d) Murray Avenue from its intersection with Scotchtown Avenue in an easterly direction to its intersection with Cahill Court.
- (e) McNally Street from its intersection with Scotchtown Avenue to its terminus in the Goshen Intermediate School parking lot.
- (f) Lincoln Avenue from its intersection with North Church Street in an easterly direction to its intersection with Erie Street.

Section 3. Severability

The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence or provision of this local law shall not affect the validity of any other part of this local law which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

Section 4. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect upon the filing of certified copies thereof with the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law.
